Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- ➔ Further refine the school's Explicit Improvement Agenda to develop a primary curriculum improvement focus to align the school's improvement priorities.
- ➔ Collaboratively develop a shared school vision for inclusion, which aligns to the Department of Education's inclusive education policy, to guide school philosophy, practices and resourcing.
- ➔ Strengthen teacher understanding and confidence with the Australian Curriculum (AC) to comprehensively align curriculum support programs to the AC achievement standards.
- ➔ Implement a whole-school approach to support teachers to increase their level of confidence and capability in planning for and delivering differentiation within classrooms, including for high-achieving students.
- ➔ Determine and embed a high-yield pedagogical approach to the teaching of writing, within the context of the AC, supported by strategies to strengthen staff capabilities.
